



Oxygen for the Needy- Saving Lives



India was badly hit by the second wave of Covid. As a country, we were ill prepared and had to face immense challenges, with despair and distress all around. Thousands and thousands fell victim to the disease, near and dear ones were lost, medical infrastructure was excessively overstretched and our oxygen supply was hopelessly inadequate resulting in misery and deaths.

Though the second wave of Covid has receded, yet we must not be led to believe that the country has turned a corner in the fight against COVID. We all are aware that many cases go unreported, particularly in rural areas where the majority of India's population lives. Medical infrastructure is awfully inadequate in rural communities, with 1 doctor for every 10,000 people and access to hospitals severely limited. It is these areas that need help.

We thank our Donors, as with their support we were able to help those in hard-to-reach communities and shall continue to do so.

Foundation distributed over 62 Oxygen Concentrators, scores of Refillable Oxygen Cylinders, Oxymeters, Sanitizers, Masks, Thermometers, Hymatic disinfectant machines and several other covid relief items. We worked with 'Ilovejaisalmer' and Smt Ruma Devi, a national Icon and Nari Shakti Puruskar awardee, for outreach to support tribal and rural artisan communities in Jaisalmer, Barmer. We were also advised, guided and helped to reach to the Governmental authorities in Himachal Pradesh Kangra Valley by Mr Rakesh Kumar, Chairman EPCH and by Chinmaya Mission. In Punjab, we were helped by Rupinder Sachdeva, Mentor Punjab Chapter of PHD Chamber for reaching out to the Deputy Commissioner Gurdaspur and through him to the Civil Hospitals in Gurdaspur, Batala and Dhariwal. For Uttarakhand Almora District we were helped by Harjit Duggal, Chairman Mata Gujri Hospital to reach out to the administrative officials in Chaukhutia. In all these Districts we donated several Oxygen concentrators. We were also helped to reach out to Delhi state MLAs Somnath Bharti, Haji Yunnus, Saurabh Bhardwaj and Madan Lal. We donated Oxygen Concentrators for Covid care in Malviya Nagar and Mustafabad constituencies. This all became possible due to our Donors' financial and material support. Thank you ALL for that. We have sent a certificate of donation cum receipt individually to each of our donor.

Our gratitude also to our supporters who helped us reach the needy communities.

Bedi Foundation is also planning relief for the needy for the third wave, that is staring us in the face. If we can, we would provide a continuous and sustainable source of oxygen for patients and are therefore exploring all avenues for an Oxygen Plant.

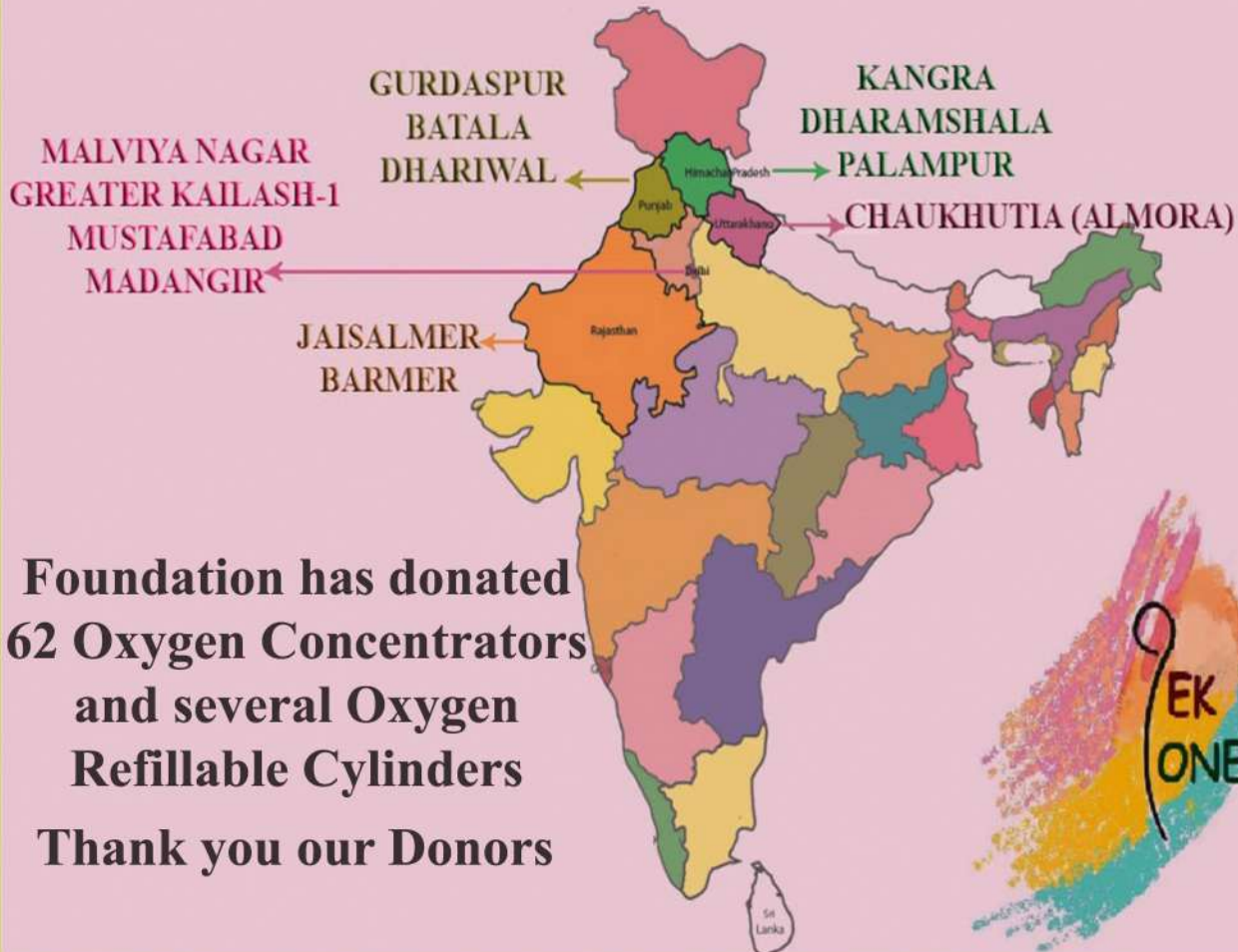
We recently sponsored for Mata Gujri Hospital, Pahadiwala Gurdwara GK 1, a Free for All Covishield Vaccination camp for reaching out to those who can not afford and do not have access to Govt facility. Over 350 persons received free vaccination.

For our usual charity in Education and Food for Hungry, new avenues have been thrown open by this horrific pandemic. It has devastated many aspects of life in India. Children have been left orphaned, they are at a greater risk of exploitation and their mental health has suffered during this catastrophic period. Vaccination levels are also shockingly low and education and livelihoods have been put on hold. There is much to do. Bedi Foundation shall continue and strive to tread the path of Sewa following our ethos of Oneness for Sarbat da Bhala.
