The projects close to our hearts are the many charitable projects we are doing in **Govt. Girls Senior Secondary School (GGSSS), Dera Baba Nanak (DBN)**. This



school comprises of 700 students and is from Grade 6 to Grade 12. Herein we owe gratitude to the Department of Education, Punjab Government and the Principal of GGSSS Mrs Rupinderjit Dhaliwal for enabling us to render support for supplementing education effort, motivating the achievers and helping the needy students. 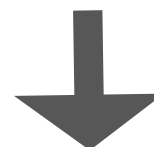
Bedi Foundation undertook two key projects at Govt. Senior Secondary Boys School to enhance the learning environment and facilities.

Enhancing Teaching Standards

In our second project at the **Government Senior Secondary Boys School**, we have taken steps to enhance the quality of education across various subjects by hiring dedicated teachers. Currently, we have the following two educators on board:

- **Ms. Priya**, a **Hindi teacher**, joined us on 3rd December 2024 to strengthen the teaching of Hindi at the school. She is a confident young woman and has already proven to be a valuable asset to the team.
- **Ms. Sumanjit Kaur**, appointed on the same day, serves as a supplementary **Punjabi** teacher - enriching language learning by connecting students with their cultural roots and improving fluency in Punjabi.

We are currently looking to recruit teachers for English and Mathematics. Any support or referrals from Foundation members in this regard would be greatly appreciated.

- Ms. Maninderdeep Kaur – Punjabi
- Mr. Gaurav Sharma – English

All three educators are performing exceptionally well and are playing a key role in raising the standard of education at the school. They are dedicated and friendly with the students, which has helped create a happy and encouraging classroom where children are learning and growing well.

A new podium was installed in the school in October 2024 and is now actively used for various events and functions. It was also proudly used during the Academic Awards Ceremony, adding a formal touch to the occasion.



Scholarship for Data Entry Operators

A scholarship of ₹10,000 was awarded to Harshita, a student of GGSSS School, for securing 1st position at the district level in the Data Entry Operator category.

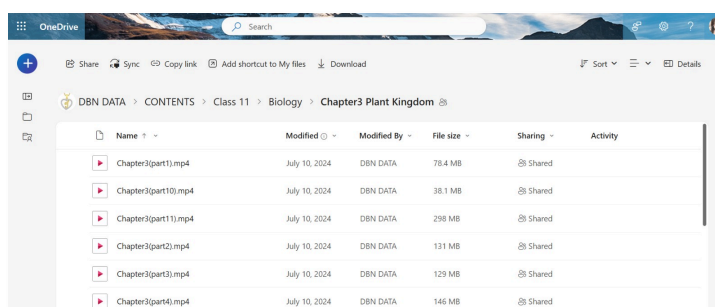
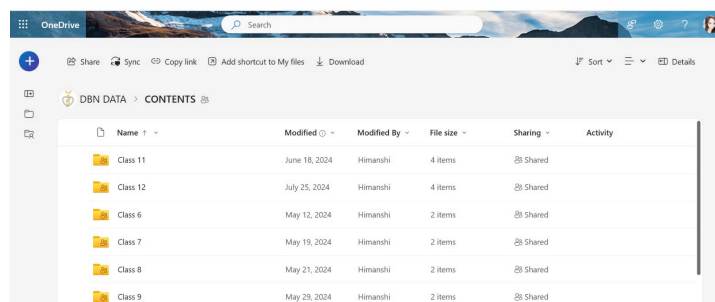
Empowering Education with Digital Content

To support students' learning in alignment with the school curriculum, the Foundation **implemented** a structured system last year for collecting, uploading, and accessing educational content.

Grade-wise and chapter-wise videos and MCQs were carefully curated, reviewed for quality, organized by class and subject, and uploaded to the school's OneDrive.

Students **accessed** this content during designated computer lab sessions, navigating clearly labeled folders to study topics at their own pace and practice with MCQs.

Teachers were also guided to use the same digital repository for self-study and classroom instruction, enabling them to



conduct more engaging and well-informed lessons.

This integrated system ensured that **both students and teachers had easy access to relevant, high-quality learning resources, helping to raise academic standards and improve exam readiness.**

Silai Skill Center

The **Salai Skill Centre**, our skilling initiative in **Apparel Designing and Stitching** launched in 2023, continues to run in full swing and has made a meaningful impact on the students of the Government School—especially young girls. Through this program, students have been introduced to the world of stitching and embroidery, developing **practical, income-generating skills** that boost their confidence and open doors to future self-employment. Many have already begun taking on small tailoring assignments within their communities, gaining both purpose and independence.
